D O G T A G S E X P I R E D

City Code prohibits dogs from running at large. Many dogs are being taken to the pound in Spokane when picked up because they are not tagged.

Please show your pet that he or she is worth the identification that a dog tag provides.

Dog tags are available at Plummer City Hall. The cost is still \$3 for dogs who have proof of distemper and rabies shots and \$10 for dogs without proof of these shots.

P U B L I C S A F E T Y

Remember that dogs are required to be kept on the owner's property or on a leash. Any dogs running at large can be impounded. Please be courteous to your neighbors.
