Budget Pay Plan

The purpose of the Budget Billing Program is to allow customers the option of paying a fixed monthly amount throughout the year. A written and signed Payment Agreement is required for all new customers wishing to participate in the Budget Billing Program. All new 2012 Budget Pay Plan participants can pick-up their Payment Agreement forms at City Hall if they have not yet received it in the mail. All participants must have the signed agreement prior to June 1, 2012 when the payment plan goes into effect. The next "Open Enrolment" for the Budget Pay Plan will begin April 2013.

The park, picnic tables, and picnic shelter are open to public use at no charge on a first come, first served basis.
