New Business:

Mountain Waterworks Pay Request #MW4— A motion was made by Weems to approve Pay Request #MW4 – Task-01 Study & Report, Task-02 Preliminary Design and Task-04 Bidding & Negotiations in the amount of \$11,531.00. Hampton seconded the motion. Motion passed.

Mountain Waterworks Pay Request #MW5— A motion was made by Bringman to approve Pay Request #MW5 – Task-04 Bidding & Negotiations in the amount of \$1,365.00. Weems seconded the motion. Motion passed.

ITD Highway Bridge Project Update – PWD, Paul Sifford and the City Clerk met with PWD Jim Kackman with the CDA Tribe to discuss the detour route for the project through the residential area of Plummer during the time of construction of the bridge replacement. Jim Kackman explained that the Tribal Council was in support of the City Council on that route that will be determined, however the Tribal Council wanted it noted that the route along 8th and P Street down to Highway 95 was their selected preference.

Williams and Parsons Financial Review – Council was briefed on the financial review from Williams and Parsons. The City Clerk explained some of the suggestions that Mr. Williams mentioned during the review process. The clerk noted that this items will be address in the future. A written report was provided to the council.

Approve Tentative Amended Budget FY2012-2013 for Publication – Hampton motioned to approve the Tentative Amended Budget for FY 2012-2013. Weems seconded the motion. Motion passed.
