BUDGET PAY

The City staff has been working diligently to get Budget Pay accounts calculated. If you have requested to be placed on the open enrollment list, your account is now being calculated to determine what your Budget Pay amount will be.

Letters and Agreement forms will be mailed to all customers who have been placed on our enrollment list. If you are a current Budget Pay customer, you will only receive a new letter and agreement form if your calculated amount changes. Agreement forms will need to be signed and returned to City Hall no later than May 30th.

The second week of May will be the last week we will accept requests to be placed on Budget Pay.

As some of you may know, the City has opted to change credit card service providers. In the past, the City has absorbed the credit/debit card fees incurred when our customers used a debit/credit card to pay their bill. After careful consideration, the City has decided not to incur the fee any longer and has switched to Access Idaho. This company does impose a fee to the user of 3% + \$1.00 when using your credit/debit card to pay your utility bill. The City only receives the payment amount of the utility bill. The City still accepts cash and/or check as payment. We would also like to announce that by choosing to go with Access Idaho, our customers can now pay their bill online @ cityofplummer.org
