High School and Jr. High students and parents are invited to observe the American Legion High School Oratorical Scholarship Program at Lakeside Elementary gym on January 31, 2015. Seating for the public will be available at 1:30 pm. Doors will close and the judging will begin at 2 pm. Plummer Post 69 is hosting the contest at the District 1 level and hopes to have high school students from the Plummer area participating in subsequent years. The contest is based on students learning about the US Constitution and being able to expound on that knowledge. Parents will appreciate this opportunity for their youth to vie for several levels of scholarship awards. The top National prize is \$18,000.

High School students legally enrolled in public, private or home school programs are eligible. Any American Legion post may conduct a contest at Post level. Since Post 69, Plummer did not have any participants this year, the District 1 Commander asked Plummer to host the contest.
