Water Conservation Tips

1. Wash Full Loads of Laundry: The washer fills up with water whether it has one item or a full load.
2. Use Cold Water: You'll save money because you're not paying to heat the water. Only use hot water for very dirty loads.
3. Use the High-Speed Spin Cycle: It removes more water, so your laundry won't need to dry as long.
4. Choose an Energy Star Washing Machine: It uses less than half the water and energy of a standard machine.
