

Plummer City Council Meeting
August 24, 2011

The Public Hearing was called to order at 6:02 p.m. by Tim Clark.

PUBLIC HEARING Mayor Clark opened the public hearing for the Budget Hearing for fiscal year 2011/2012 at 6:02. Clerk stated that proper legal requirements for advertisement of the hearing have been fulfilled as required by the Plummer City Code and by the laws of the State of Idaho. Advertisement was posted in The St. Maries Gazette for two consecutive weeks before the public hearing. Dates of publication were August 10th and 17th, 2011.

Hearing rules were read by Mayor Clark. Reason for public hearing was stated by Mayor. There was no testimony in favor of or neutral to, or in opposition to budget hearing. Question from Dan Jolibois regarding why the budget is so much lower this year than last year, Treasurer stated that the lower budget was due to construction costs last year for the Waste Water Treatment Plant.

CLOSED HEARING: Hearing was closed at 6:11

DELIBERATION: There were no questions, or comments from staff or council.

DECISION: The Council's decision on August 24, 2011 was to approve budget for fiscal year 2011/2012. Tim Stockdale made a motion to approve the budget for fiscal year 2011/2012. Motion was seconded by Terry Allen.

The official roll call vote as follows: Taylor aye, Allen aye, Wheaton aye, and Stockdale aye.

REGULAR MEETING ITEMS:

CEMETERY FEES Gloria Cuthbert requested the city lower the fees to open and close the grave sites. John Wheaton made a motion to table till next month, and have the crew leader get a cost of what it costs to open and close the sites. Terry Allen seconded the motion. Motion passed.

COMPRESSOR: Review quote from Ingersoll Rand. It was the consensus of the council to move ahead with purchasing the compressor with the money we receive from Blue Water for the sale of the panel. This was approved previously by council to purchase.
