Trevor Mokry- Crew has been busy with new hook ups around town. We did have the divers come in and assess the upper water tank and patch some holes. They cleaned out the tanks and the city should be good for another two years.

Cory Long- Busy with new connections. It has helped that we have a new lineman on the crew. Rhiannon Veltri-Still working on bank reconciliations. She ended up sending a letter to a landowner about a back bill on a resident that was renting the space that had been accruing since 2013. The landowner decided to go ahead and demolish the trailer. That was when she had to inform them that to get another trailer on that property the previous back bill needed to be paid in full per ordinance in order to have services turned back on. Councilor Carpenter asked a question about a resident that was on the council agenda last month and her building permit. City Clerk Veltri informed him, the resident came in and paid the building permit fees and was able to continue her building.
