Approved USKH Pay Request #42 - \$1750.00 for Professional Services: Weems motioned to approve Pay Request #42 in the amount of \$1,750.00 to USKH for professional services. Hampton seconded the motion. Motion passed.

Installation of Camera's:A motion made by Weems to accept the bid from Justin Hall and Brian Morris in the amount of \$1200.00 which will install and supply software installation of the purchased Security Camera's. Stockdale seconded the motion. Motion passed.

BUDGET WORKSHOP:At this time the overall budget is requiring addition reductions. Joann presented the council with an overall reduction based on the new accounting system of fund balance. Council has requested that we continue working on the reductions starting with the General Fund. Joann presented 3 worksheets for the 2012-2013 Budget representing information on budgets with a 0%, 3%, and a combination of 3% and requested wage increases for increases in wages for the employee's. Terry will work with department heads to determine the direction of the wage increase as directed by the city's policy manual. An additional Budget Meeting was set for July 19, 2012 to review the General Fund. Joann provided a list of concerns that have been brought to the attention of the council for consideration of the new budget. The council has decided to introduce a new fee for Notary's at \$5.00 per stamp.
