AMEND AGENDA Motion was made by Weems move presentation by Bill Burke from IRWA to first topic on agenda, motion was seconded by Hampton. Motion passed.

PRESENTATION BILL BURKE - IRWA Bill presented to council the Rate Study results for the City of Plummer Sewer Rates. The current rate chart indicates the need for an increase to the current sewer rate in excess of \$16.00 per EDU. It has been recommended that the depreciation of the plant be utilized to continue working on I & I issues. Bill stated that the city needs to continue to work in removing I & I and work toward obtaining the levels of capacity that the plant was designed for. Bringman asked the question of long term use of E3 and recognized that the city still needs to work toward training a backup operator for the plant. Cross functional training and certification is certain and a need for a back-up operator is certain in the future. Bill recommends that the city needs to revisit the smoke testing and determine what the city ordinance currently states and work to implement to aide in the improvement of I & I.

BUDGET WORKSHOP Review figures for next fiscal year. JoAnn and Debbie will work together to review the current 2012 budget and review the adjustments needed to meet the proposed 2013 fiscal year.
