OLD BUSINESS:

Church of Latter-Day Saints Kip Clark: The mayor addressed Mr. Clark on whether the organization had a secondary location in place if the community center was not available at the time of their request. It was stated by Mr. Clark that they do have another location available if necessary. It was discussed by council that the city has no problem with anyone donating time or funds to the city at any time, however it was not to be misinterpreted as an exchange for the use of the community center and all fee's for the use will be paid as policy states. In addition to the weekly rental fees it was explained to Mr. Clark that at a time where a community member is requesting to rent the building at the same time, the community member will take precedence and contact from city hall will be made to Mr. Clark by the Friday before to allow time for Mr. Clark to obtain another location.

Bringman made a motion to allow the Church of Latter- Day Saints to rent the community center on Sunday's from November 2012 through March 2013 utilizing the standard application form and Community Center Policy. Hampton seconded the motion. Motion passed.
